This Driver was working alone and could not leave his horses to pick a route, nevertheless he made three such trips successfully and delivere the water and ammunition when it was much ne ded. His courage and daring was of the highest order. On one oc asion his limber overturned and only by his skilful horsemanshild did he prevent his wagon and hobses from orashing down into the ravine.
